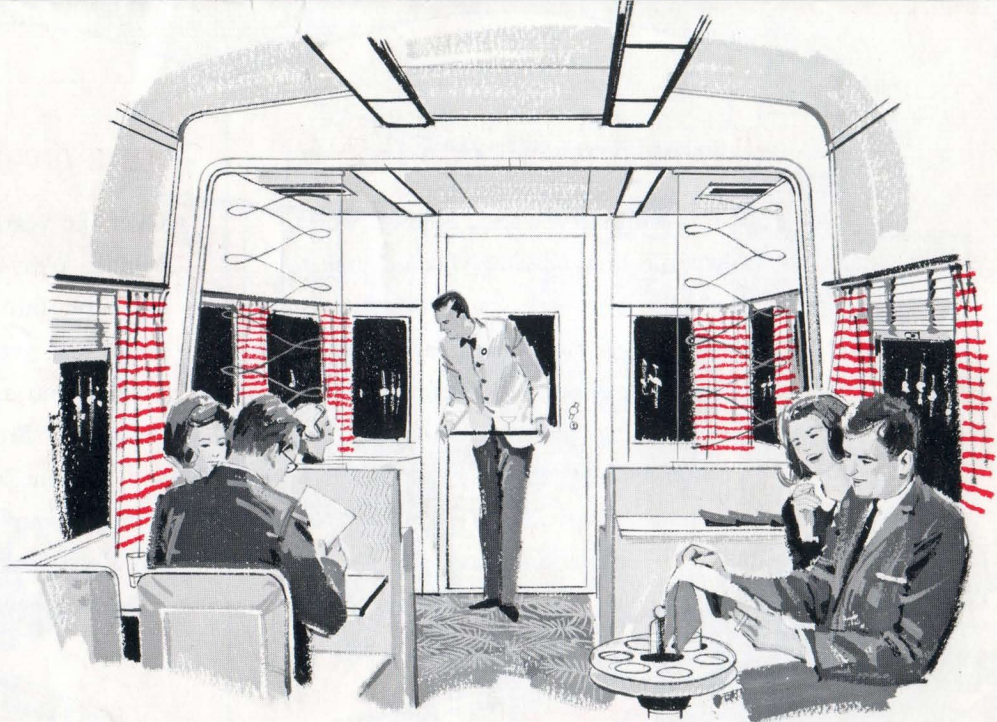

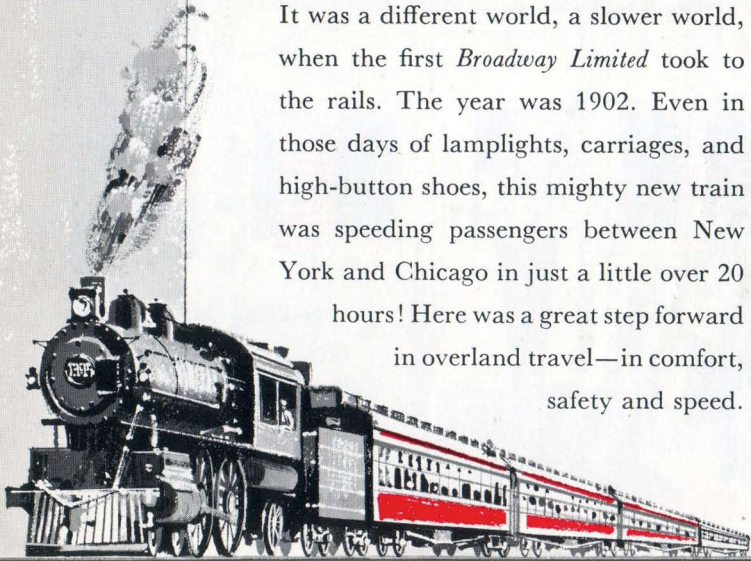

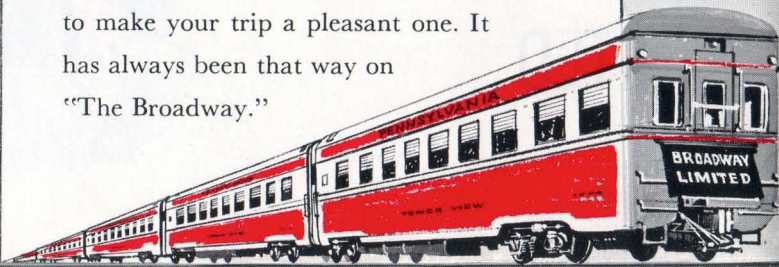
It was a great train then...

It's a greater train today!

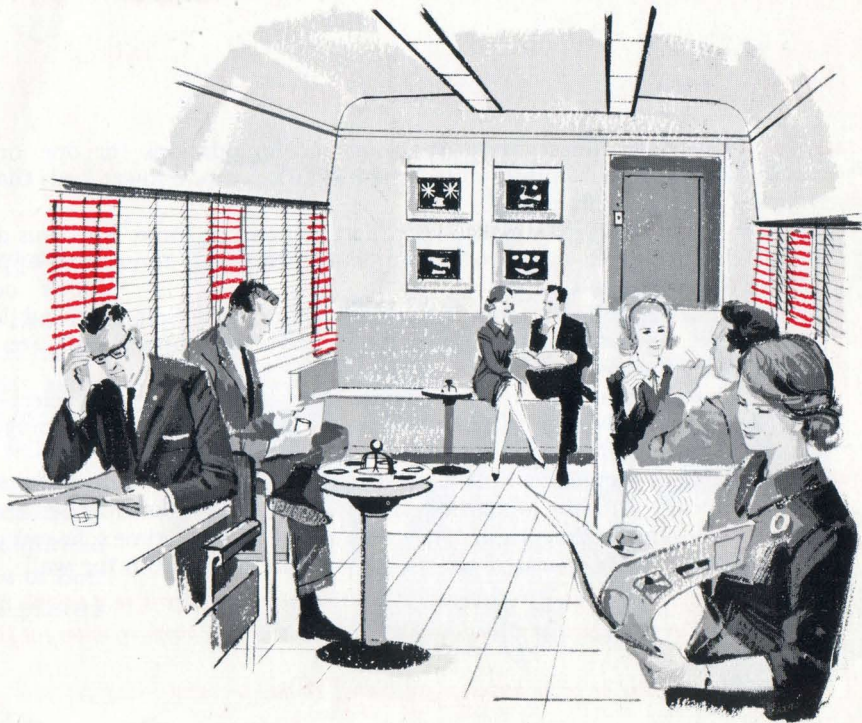

Both the Mid-Train Lounge and the Observation Lounge on the *Broadway* are richly appointed havens for ease and sociability. Modern motifs, inviting furnishings combine to make them so. Sofas and easy chairs, beverage service, latest periodicals, writing desks . . . yours to use when the spirit moves you to roam and relax . . . sip and chat.

What more do you need—a telephone? There's one in the Mid-Train Lounge. Calls can be made in areas of major cities *en route*.



Private Rooms...6 Types for Choosing!

MASTER ROOMS—finest, most spacious accommodations for one or two. Shower bath, four comfortable lounge chairs, radio, 2 lower beds that fold away when not in use.

DRAWING ROOMS—with room to spare for one, two or three. Spacious during the day with sofa and two lounge chairs. At night, three beds appear—two lowers plus an upper.

COMPARTMENTS—offer appointments for one or two. Sofa-seat and lounge chair for daytime relaxation. At night, lower and upper beds are made ready for slumber.

BEDROOMS—are available in three distinct styles for one or two travelers—with either a sofa, sofa-seat or lounge chairs for hours awake. For sleeping, each offers inviting lower and upper beds.

DUPLEX ROOMS—a choice of novel, restful two-level “apartments” for individual travelers. A roomy lounge sofa transforms into a comfortable bed at night.

ROOMETTES—ideal coziness and privacy for one. A wide daytime sofa-seat makes way for an easily operated pre-made bed that lowers from the wall.

Each room has a lavatory. (In rooms for two or more, lavatory is in a private annex.)

Bedrooms and Compartments can be converted into one large room or suites for families or small groups.

For refreshments or other services—including clothes pressing—ring for your porter.





Dining...a delight on the Broadway!

You dine with soft light and music. Here is excellent service, too. You'll notice it in little things—like the complimentary newspaper at breakfast, or the special care that keeps "hot foods hot" from kitchen to table. You sense and realize the skill and care of master chefs. Menu offers a wide choice of dinner selections ranging from Charcoal Broiled Sirloin Steak and Roast Prime Ribs of Beef Au Jus, to delectable salad platters for the calorie-conscious.



No "Lug" in Luggage in Chicago

Taking a taxi? Ask porter to tag your luggage. On arrival, go directly to taxicab stand. Pick up your luggage there at the prevailing Red Cap fee.

When returning same day...

on the eastbound *Broadway Limited* or *The General* you may transfer luggage to your room at a cost of 75 cents per bag including Red Cap fee. Ask porter for tags. Charge will be collected when Red Cap delivers luggage to train.

If you are continuing Westward...

transfer luggage from your room to accommodation on any of these trains leaving same day at a charge of 75 cents per bag including Red Cap fee. Charge collected on outgoing train. Ask your porter.

This service does not apply to radios, books, clothing, etc.
