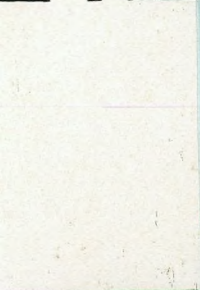

For, resting royally on luxurious lounges or in inviting chairs, guests may enjoy the scenery, converse with friends, read or relax, as the spirit moves.

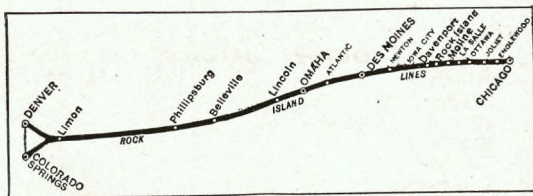

Especial attention is directed to the coach service of this train, which provides free through reclining-chair cars in both directions. The chairs are comfortable and restful; there is a large and attractive smoking-room; toilet facilities are adequate; the cars are well ventilated, always in order and scrupulously clean—an economical but happy method of sure and safe transportation.
