Rivaling the Harlequin Room in popularity is the Harvey House Grill, where steaks and chops are broiled to individual tastes on an open charcoal grill. A Coffee Shop and a Cafe-teria round off this variety of food services. There is also a stylish little specialty shop, the Hospitality Shop, offering Fred Harvey candy, coffee, jams, jellies, liquor, ice cream and a number of smart gift items.

Other Fred Harvey restaurants in Greater Chicago are the Dearborn and Union Station Restaurants and the Old Spinning Wheel in Hinsdale.

In 1951, Fred Harvey took over the eating facilities in one of Chicago's most distinguished office buildings and converted them into a group of restaurants rated among the finest in the city. The most prominent of these is the Harlequin Room, a festive room which takes its name from a mural by Karin and Ernst van Leyden depicting a harlequinade in the style of the 16th Century Commedia dell'Arte. The charming con-temporary French decor, heavy Irish linen, sparkling silver and especially designed china give the room a well-bred atmosphere and account—in addition to fine food and service—for its popularity with advertising men, the entertainment world and Chicago society.
