GENERAL INFORMATION

No extra fare on any Burlington Train

These Time Tables show when trains are scheduled to arrive at and depart from stations, and connect with other trains, but the Company will not be responsible for the consequences of delayed arrivals or departures, nor for damage resulting from strikes, riots, acts of God or of the public enemy. The Company reserves the right to discontinue trains, change schedules, and substitute equipment, and will not be responsible for resulting inconvenience or damage. These schedules are published as public information, and great care is taken to keep them correct, but the Company will not be responsible for errors or omissions, and does not guarantee its published schedules or connections.

Time from 12.01 midnight to 12.00 noon is shown by **LIGHT** faced figures, and time from 12.01 noon to 12.00 midnight by **HEAVY** faced figures.

Buy Tickets before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge.

Children under 5 years of age, free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age or over, full fare. Ask agent about additional reductions under the Family Fare Plan.

Adjustment of Fares. In case of disagreement with conductor or agent, pay the fare requested, take receipt and communicate with W. F. Burke, General Passenger Traffic Manager, Chicago.

Redemption of Tickets—Tickets of CB&Q issue, unused or partly used will be redeemed according to tariff regulations at proper value by making application to Mr. H. W. Dehning, Auditor of Revenues, 547 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago 6, Illinois.

Baggage. Baggage should be checked at least 30 minutes before departure of the train on which it is desired that it move. Every effort is made for prompt handling of baggage, but cannot guarantee forwarding on same train as passenger, nor can time of arrival be guaranteed. Free allowance is 150 pounds on one adult ticket (300 pounds on a family-plan ticket) subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight, value and size; excess value to be declared and paid for at time of checking.

The following articles are among several that are too fragile or too valuable to be handled in checked baggage and will not be accepted: China, Glass or Silverware, Clocks or Watches, Firearms (small) and Ammunition, Foodstuffs, Frag-

ile Articles, Fruit (canned or fresh), Household Articles, Jewelry, Liquids of any kind, Money, Perishable Articles, Phonograph Records, Radios, Television Sets, Typewriters (Portable), Valuable Papers (Bonds, etc.), Paper cartons weighing more than 50 pounds. The carriers will not be responsible for loss, damage or injury to any such property contained in baggage.

Bicycles (not motorcycles), baby carriages, and guns are transported in baggage cars, subject to tariff regulations. **Dogs** in crates or muzzled on leash will also be handled in baggage cars on trains that have baggage cars, subject to tariff regulations. On trains not provided with baggage cars, dogs in crates will be handled only at owner's risk. See reference notes in schedule tables for trains which do not have baggage cars.

Lost Articles—Agents will do all in their power to assist in the recovery of lost articles. **Passengers should not only give full description of the property, but should state date of loss, number of train and whether left in coach, or Pullman car.** Inquire of Manager Baggage Traffic, Chicago, or his Assistant at Omaha, Neb. **No responsibility is assumed** for unchecked articles left in stations or cars.

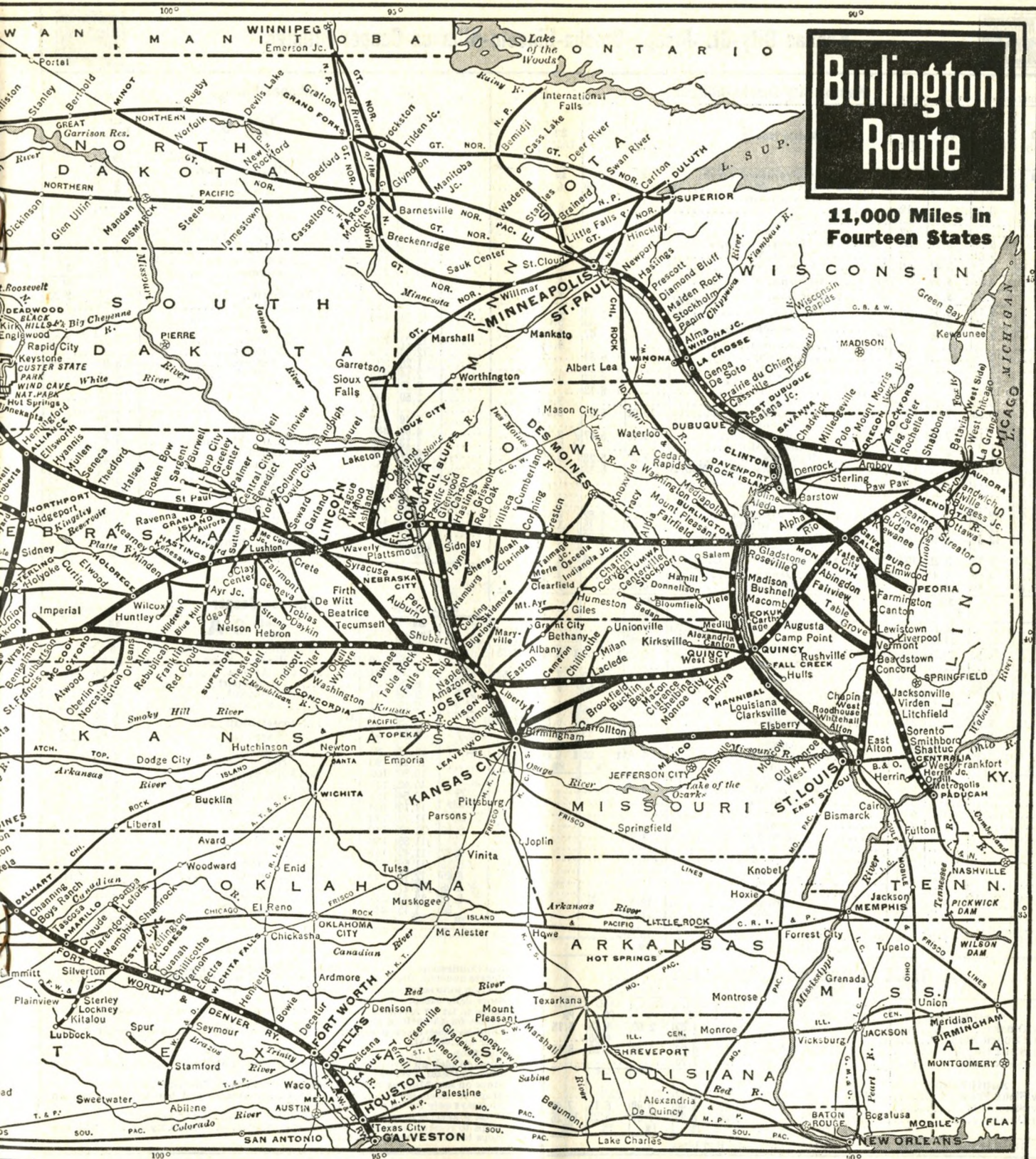

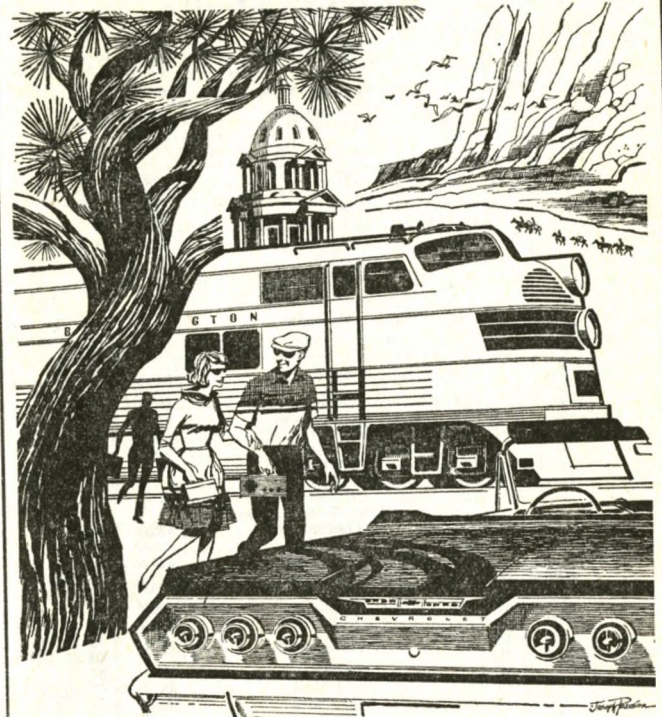

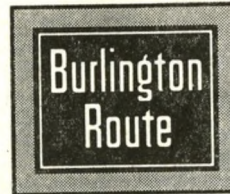

A DRAWING-ROOM contains a lower and an upper berth, a sofa, a washstand, and toilet annex; a compartment contains a lower and an upper berth, with washstand and toilet; a bedroom, duplex roomette, duplex-single room or roomette is a small compartment, varying in style, containing a bed, washstand and toilet. A double bedroom also contains an upper berth.

Minimum number of adult tickets required for occupancy of sleeping car space for night service in Western territory: Bedroom Suite, Two tickets; Drawing-room, One and One-quarter tickets; Co-sleeping room, One ticket; Duplex Single Room, Roomette, or Duplex Roomette, One ticket. Occupancy of a drawing-room in parlor car, or standard sleeping car for day service only, requires two tickets and payment of three seat fares.
