## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Schedule or Equipment Changes

—These Time Tables show when trains are scheduled to arrive at and depart from stations, and connect with other trains, but the Company will not be responsible for the consequences of delayed arrivals or departures, nor for damage resulting from strikes, riots, acts of God or of the public enemy. The Company reserves the right to discontinue trains, change schedules, and substitute equipment, and will not be responsible for resulting inconvenience or damage. These schedules are published as public information, and great care is taken to keep them correct, but the Company will not be responsible for errors or omissions, and does not guarantee its published schedules or connections.

**Time** from 12.01 midnight to 12.00 noon is shown by LIGHT faced figures, and time from **12.01** noon to **12.00** midnight by **HEAVY** faced figures.

**Purchasing Tickets**—Buy Tickets before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge.

**Children** under **5** years of age, free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; **5** years of age and under **12**, one-half fare; **12** years of age or over, full fare. Ask agent about additional reductions under the Family Fare Plan.

**Passenger Service on Mixed Trains**—Transportation is available in mixed passenger-freight trains on some

branch lines. Consult agent for details.

**Adjustment of Fares.** In case of disagreement with conductor or agent, pay the fare requested, take receipt and communicate with W. F. Burke, General Passenger Traffic Manager, Chicago, Illinois 60606.

**Redemption of Tickets.** Tickets of CB&Q issue, unused or partly used will be redeemed according to tariff regulations at proper value by making application to Mr. W. L. Blume, Manager, Revenue Accounting, 547 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois 60606.

**Baggage.** Baggage should be checked at least one hour before departure of the train on which it is desired that it move. Every effort is made for prompt handling of baggage, but we cannot guarantee that it will be forwarded on same train as passenger, nor can time of arrival be guaranteed. Up to 150 pounds of baggage may be checked on a regular adult ticket and 300 pounds on a family-plan ticket. Checkable hand baggage that may be conveniently carried by hand is subject to a 25c service charge, with a charge of 50c for trunks and checkable items other than hand baggage. Items offered for checking are subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight, value and size; service charges and excess value to be declared and paid for at time of checking.

The following articles are among

several that are too fragile or too valuable to be handled in checked baggage and will not be accepted: China, Glass or Silverware, Clocks or Watches, Firearms (small) and Ammunition, Foodstuffs, Fragile Articles, Fruit (canned or fresh), Household Articles, Jewelry, Liquids of any kind, Money, Perishable Articles, Phonograph Records, Radios, Television Sets, Typewriters (Portable), Valuable Papers (Bonds, etc.), Paper cartons weighing more than 50 pounds. The carriers will not be responsible for loss, damage or injury to any such property contained in baggage.

**Bicycles** (not motorcycles), **baby carriages, and guns** are transported in baggage cars, subject to tariff regulations. Only dogs in substantial well-ventilated crates will be handled in baggage service subject to baggage restrictions and tariff regulations. See reference notes in schedule tables regarding restricted handling of baggage on certain trains.

**Lost Articles.** Agents will lend all possible assistance to effect recovery of lost articles. **Passengers should not only give full description of the property, but should state date of loss, number of train and whether left in coach, or Pullman car.** Inquire of Manager Baggage Traffic, Chicago, or his Assistant at Omaha, Neb. **No responsibility is assumed** for unchecked articles left in stations or cars.

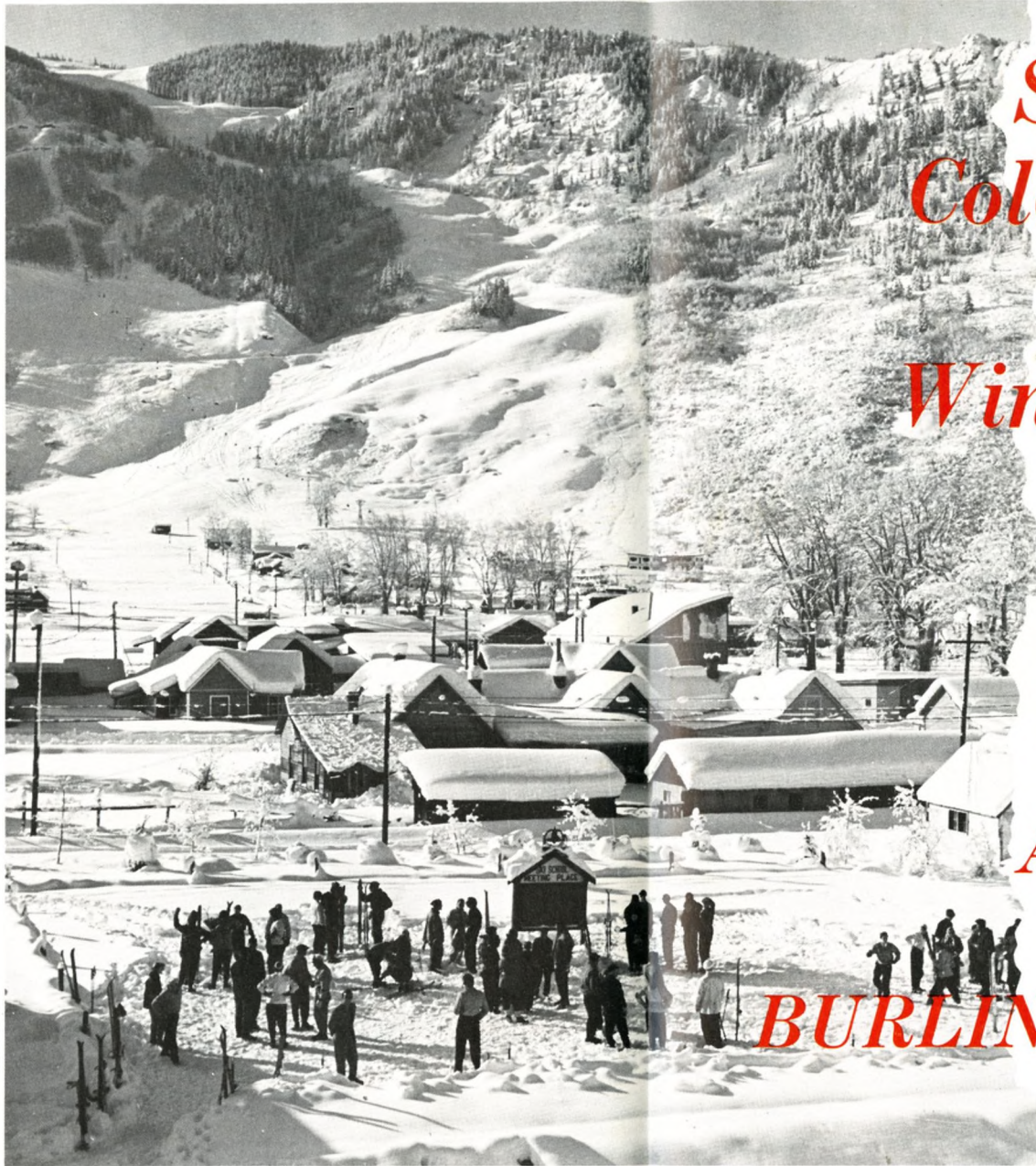
